I, the undersigned



1.2. I am one of the petitioners who signed the petition in terms of the provision
 of Section 98(9) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 200
 of 1994("the Constitution"), the contents of which petition the Speaker of




the National Assembly has referred to this Honourable Court for determination in terms of Section 98(2)(d) of the Constitution.

- 1.3. I am duly authorised to depose to this affidavit on behalf of each of the petitioners who are members of the Democratic Party.


2. Save where the context indicates to the contrary or I state otherwise, the facts herein contained are within my personal knowledge. They are to the best of my knowledge and belief true and correct.

3. I have read the affidavit of Pieter Gabriel Marais (and the annexures thereto), which he deposed to during December 1995 on behalf of each of the petitioners who are members of the National Party and with the purpose of placing before this Honourable Court *factual information relevant to the questions which are to be determined by this Honourable Court.*
