DIRECTIONS DATED 4 OCTOBER 2005

The Chief Justice has given the following directions concerning the above-mentioned matter:

1. This matter is set down for hearing on 8 November 2005.
2. The applicant is required to lodge her affidavit on or before 19 October 2005, if the applicant wishes to oppose the application.
3. Written argument must be lodged as follows:
 - a) On behalf of the first respondent on or before 25 October 2005; and
 - b) On behalf of the applicant, if any, on or before 1 November 2005.
4. Written argument must also address the following questions:
 - a) The circumstances under which this Court may extend the period of suspension of the declaration of invalidity in the light of our decision in *Minister of Justice v Ntuli* 1997 (3) SA 772 (CC).

- b) In the absence of paragraph (e)(3)(g) of the Order of this Court made on 15 October 2005, would this Court have the power to extend the period of suspension of the declaration of invalidity?
