DIRECTIONS : DATED 30 JUNE 2004

The Chief Justice has given the following directions concerning this matter;

1. The application for leave to appeal is set down for hearing before the Constitutional Court at 10.00 am on Monday 19 July 2004. If the matter is not disposed of on 19 July argument will continue to not later than 1.00 pm on 20 July.
2. The arguments of the parties must address the merits of the application so that the application can be disposed of without hearing further argument if leave to appeal is granted.

3. If the amicus curiae who addressed argument to the High Court wishes to make representations to the Constitutional Court it shall give notice of its intention to do so by not later than 3 July and, subject to paragraph 4 of these directions, may submit written argument to the Court in accordance with the provisions of rules 10 (7) and (8)
4. Written argument shall be lodged as follows:
 - (a) On behalf of the applicant, by 7 July
 - (b) On behalf of the respondent, by 13 July
 - (c) On behalf of the amicus curiae, if notice is given in terms of paragraph 3, by 15 July. Such argument must comply strictly with the provisions of rules 10 (7) and (8)
5. The amicus curiae shall not, without leave of the Court, present oral argument to the Court at the hearing of the application.
