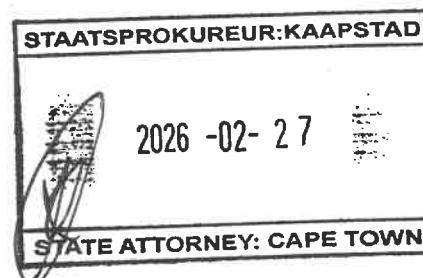

**FOUNDING AFFIDAVIT  
(CONDONATION APPLICATION)**

I, the undersigned,

**LAWRENCE SIBUSISO NGWENYA**



do hereby make oath and state that:

1. I am an adult male attorney practising as such at the Office of the State Attorney (Cape Town). In my aforementioned capacity, I act on behalf of the first applicant.
2. The contents of this affidavit are true and correct and fall within my personal knowledge, unless otherwise stated or clear from the context.
3. The purpose of this affidavit is to set out the facts that led to the late service of the record by 5 days, and the late filing by 10 court days. It was due on 13 February 2026 but was served on all the parties on 20 February 2025 and will be filed on 27 February 2026. I seek the Court's condonation for such late filing.
4. I accept that any lateness, regardless of its duration, is a serious matter. Nevertheless, I respectfully submit that there has been no undue delay in the service and filing of the record.


#### **FACTS LEADING TO THE DELAY**

5. On 22 December 2025 via the Registrar's office, the Chief Justice issued directions dealing with the further conduct of the matter ("the directions"). The directions, which I attach as "LN1", require the applicants in the two cases (CCT103/25 and CCT144/25) to file the record by 13 February 2026.

The dates for the filing of submissions are also set out in the directions. A hearing date is yet to be determined.


6. A candidate attorney in my office, Nurjehan Emaran had been assigned the task of preparing a draft index. However, our offices closed on 24 December 2025 and reopened on 2 January 2026.
7. Ms Emaran returned to office on 5 January 2026 and continued with the assimilation of documents and the preparation of a draft index.
8. By 20 January 2026, Ms Emaran prepared a draft index which she sent via email to all parties and invited any comments. The email incorrectly refers to a “draft order” when it meant to state “draft index”. I attach the email as “LN2”.
9. On 26 January 2026 we received an email from Mr Dadoo of the Legal Resources Centre (“LRC”), the attorneys of record of the second applicant. He informed us that he had emailed the Registrar of the Constitutional Court (“CC”) asking whether a consolidated record in respect of both cases CCT103/25 and CCT144/25 is to be compiled or whether separate records are to be compiled.
10. The LRC further provided a list of four documents that, for the purposes of its client’s application, should be included in the record. I attach his email as “LN3”.

11. The Registrar of the CC replied to the LRC's query on 30 January 2026 in which it was confirmed that the records in the two cases must not be consolidated. I attach the Registrar's response as "LN4".
12. On 4 February 2026 and after conducting an urgent procurement process, my office appointed Inlexso Innovative Legal Solutions to compile the record. The circumstances surrounding the procurement of a professional service provider to compile the record are as follows –
  - 12.1. The attorneys of the applicant in case number CCT144/2025 circulated a draft index of its record on 2 February 2026.
  - 12.2. In perusing the draft, we realised that it was prepared by a professional external service provider. Prior to seeing this draft index, we intended to compile the record ourselves but then decided to have a professional service provider do so. This would also ensure that the record will comply with the requirements of Rule 20(2).
  - 12.3. Thus, on 3 February 2026 we invited suitable service providers that are listed on the National Treasury's database to quote. We stipulated the deadline for the record as being 13 February 2026. Inlexso confirmed that it would be able to meet such deadline.
  - 12.4. Inlexso was appointed on 4 February 2026.

13. This appointment was a positive development as I was concerned about the looming deadline. However, as will become clear below, clerical errors combined with an incessant connectivity and technological problems at the State Attorney's office led to the finalised record being served on 20 February 2026 and being filed on 27 February 2026.
14. On 4 February 2026, my office provided Inlexso with a copy of the draft index which Ms Emaran had already circulated on 20 January 2026 (previously attached as LN2) together with a copy of the paginated record in accordance with the draft index.
15. During the late afternoon of Friday, 6 February 2026, Inlexso provided me with the newly prepared draft index.
16. On Monday, 9 February 2026, I circulated the draft index to all parties and called upon them to comment on the draft by 10 February 2026. I attach this email as "LN5".
17. On 10 February 2026 (at about 10h56) the LRC responded in which it commented on the draft index and listed four documents to be included in the bundle. These were the same documents the LRC mentioned in its email of 26 January 2026. Essentially these are the affidavits filed in respect of the second applicant's application. I attach the email as "LN6".



18. Unfortunately, I was not in ready possession of these documents as I could not immediately locate them. Thus, at about 11h57 on 10 February 2026, I requested a copy of the documents from the LRC.
19. At about 12h21 on 10 February 2026, the LRC responded and provided us with three links to the requested documents. Two features of this email bears mentioning –
- 19.1. First, neither I nor my office could access these documents via the links.
- 19.2. Second, the links were to three documents, not four as listed in LN6. Missing from the list was the first respondent's Answering Affidavit to the second applicant's application. I did not pick up on this omission at the time.
20. On 11 February 2026, I responded to the LRC and informed them that I was unable to access the documents. I attach the email exchanges at "LN7".
21. At the same time, my secretary, Ms B Cata, forwarded the links provided by the LRC to Inlexso in the hope that they could access the links. I attach Ms Cata's email as "LN8". We were unsure as to why we could not access the links and suspected that it might have been as a result of our office's connectivity problems. For an extended period our office has been plagued


with network and connectivity problems. Unfortunately, this results in inconsistent email service and a hindrance to accessing documents online.

22. On 12 February 2026, concerned that the record had not yet been completed, I attended at the office of Inlexso in Cape Town's CBD. The aim was to personally inspect the draft record to see whether any documents were missing. I then discovered that Inlexso had not received the email from my office which contained the links to the second applicant's documents. (already attached as LN8). We are unable to explain why this email was blocked or simply never arrived in the inbox of Inlexso.
23. After a number of back-and-forth between the LRC, Inlexso and I in attempting to place Inlexso in possession of the documents, Inlexso was provided with accessible links to the documents by the LRC at about noon on 12 February 2026.
24. During the afternoon of 12 February 2026, Ms Cata, and I contacted Inlexso separately on multiple occasions to ascertain the progress made in preparing the index and record. The person preparing the record, Ms Millicent King informed my secretary that she would continue working on the record even if it meant doing so after hours that evening.
25. After liaising with Inlexso on the morning of 13 February 2026, I received an amended draft index at 12h57 on 13 February 2026. Unfortunately, it later


became clear that this draft did not include all the documents which the LRC had requested to be included. It still had not included the second applicant's replying affidavit.

26. There was a further exchange of emails and documents during the afternoon in which the LRC provided feedback on the next iteration of the index.
27. At about 16h35 on 13 February 2026, I received a revised copy of the index from Inlexso. At 16h56 on 13 February 2026, I then sent an email to all parties attaching the final index and stating that the record will be finalised in accordance with this index and stated that the bundle would be served electronically on the same day. I attach a copy of this email as "LN9".
28. However, Inlexso did not finalise the record itself and Ms King of Inlexso informed me at 16h49 that she would return on the Saturday to continue working on the record. I did not hear from Ms King for the rest of the weekend.
29. At 12h41 on Sunday 15 February 2026, I sent the certificates to the LRC for their signature affirming that the index and record are correct. However, on Monday 16 February 2026, the LRC responded stating that they, understandably, needed the record itself before signing the certificate. At 09h20 that morning Ms Emaran sent an email to Inlexso, requesting that they


provide the record. I sent a follow up email to Inlexso at 12h19 requesting the record. I attach this exchange as “LN10”.

30. At about 14h57 on 16 February 2026 I received a We-Transfer link from Inlexso to the finalised record. Ms Cata then on-sent the link to the LRC about an hour later. After receiving the link, the LRC responded stating that they were unable to open several Volumes, and Volumes 1 – 10 did not form part of the documents in the link. I then asked Inlexso to send the link directly to LRC. I attach this email exchange as “LN11”.
31. The problem persisted for most of 17 February 2026 as the LRC still could not access the full record. Inlexso then sent scanned versions and the LRC provided its feedback on the record at about 17h57 on 17 February 2026. I attach this email exchange as “LN12”.
32. The issues raised in the LRC email of 17h57 were concerning and this led me to visit the offices of Inlexso during the morning of 18 February 2026 to resolve the issues. During my inspection, it became apparent that the link originally sent by the LRC on 11 February 2026 did not contain the first respondent’s answering affidavit and annexures. Thus, even though it was listed in the index, it was not in the record itself.
33. Another candidate attorney, upon my instruction, addressed an email to the LRC at about 12h27 on 18 February 2026 requesting a copy of the affidavit.

The LRC responded a few minutes later and provided a copy thereof. I attach this exchange as “LN13”.

34. With regard to the other discrepancies raised by the LRC, I instructed Inlexso at the meeting on 18 February 2026 to effect the relevant changes to the record and index.
35. There was a further exchange of emails between my office and the LRC which resulted in a further amendment on 19 February 2026.
36. The finalised bundle was then sent to me at about 12h00 on 20 February 2026 by Inlexso. Soon thereafter, I served the record via email on all the parties on 20 February 2026. I attach the email which provided all the parties with a link to the record as “LN14”. As will be noted, the LRC confirmed receipt later that day.
37. A hard copy of the record was couriered to our correspondent over the weekend of 20 February 2026. However, on Monday 23 February 2026, when the record was presented for filing at the CC, filing was refused as it needed to be accompanied by a condonation application.
38. Ms Emaran and I then consulted with counsel on 24 February 2026 and provided a raft of emails and instructions setting out the above sequence of events for the purpose of preparing a condonation application. I was

provided with a draft condonation application the late afternoon on the next day.

39. Even though not all the emails and exchanges are included above, the salient facts are set out above and amount to a reasonably detailed account. I have been candid in the events and in setting out the numerous shortcomings in the process.


## **THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE**

### **The nature of the relief and nature of the underlying issues**


40. The first applicant seeks condonation for the late filing of the record. Without condonation, both applicants will be severely prejudiced as, I assume, the matter will not be heard.
41. The main application is of great significance and involves weighty issues of holding Parliament to account on how it involves the public in the legislation-making process. Further, the case involves legislation that will have widespread and intensive impact on both government and the private sector. It is thus of critical importance that this Court adjudicates the dispute.

### **The extent of the delay and prejudice**

42. The delay in serving the record is five court days and the delay in filing the record is ten court days.



43. I submit that this is not an inordinate delay.
44. Further, given that the record was served on the parties on 20 February 2026, it is submitted that—
- 44.1. the second applicant have sufficient time to include references to the record in its submissions, which are due on 27 February 2026; and
- 44.2. the respondents have sufficient time to include references to their submissions, which are due on 13 March 2026.
45. I further submit the explanation for the delay is not unreasonable. While we perhaps naively assumed we would compile the record ourselves in accordance with the Rules, this led to the delay in appointing the external service provider. This delay was exacerbated by IT problems, clerical errors in not picking up soon enough which documents were not sent to or having reached Inlexso and the like.
46. The delay was not wilful. I have, since 22 December 2025, put in motion the compilation of the record. The multiple emails that were exchanged, as evidenced above, bears testimony to my bona fide attempts at meeting the deadline. And when the deadline was not met, I continued in my efforts at minimising the period of delay as much as possible.

**CONCLUSION**

47. I therefore submit that it is in the interests of justice for the filing of the record to be condoned. I further submit that I have shown good cause for the late filing to be condoned.
48. I request that the Court grant the order as set out in the Notice of Motion.





  - (b) the second applicant in each case, on or before Friday, 27 February 2026, such submissions to be a single set of consolidated submissions covering both cases and not to exceed 25 pages;
  - (c) the third applicant in CCT 144/25, on or before Friday, 27 February 2026, such submissions not to exceed 25 pages;
  - (d) the opposing respondents in each case, on or before Friday, 13 March 2026, such submissions in each case not to exceed 60 pages.
4. The submissions of the second and third applicants shall, as far as practically possible, not repeat submissions contained in those filed by the first applicant in each of the cases.
5. Further directions may be issued.

Thank you, I confirm receipt of the complete application earlier these evening.

However, several issues raised in previous correspondence have not been addressed.

First, as raised on Friday, the Second Applicant's Application for Condonation was filed in respect of the late filing of the Second Applicant's Replying Affidavit, however it still appears out of sync in Volume 16 and not accompanying the relevant Replying Affidavit in Volumes 20 and 21.

The correct order of documents, reflecting the flow and clear dates on which pleadings were filed, should be:

1. The Second Applicants' Application for Intervention (consisting of the relevant Notice of Motion and Founding Affidavit and accompanying annexures);
2. The Second Applicants' Consolidated Founding Affidavit and accompanying annexures;
3. The First Respondent's Answering Affidavit and accompanying annexures;
4. The Second Applicant's Application for Condonation for the Late Filing of their Consolidated Replying Affidavit and accompanying annexures; and
5. The Second Applicant's Consolidated Replying Affidavit and accompanying annexures.

Second, the individual index of Volume 17 still reflects that the First Respondent's Answering Affidavit as filed in response to the Second Applicant's Application for Condonation and not that it was filed in response to the Second Applicant's Consolidated Founding Affidavit.


There are also several further additional mistakes in the record.

First, Volume 17 actually includes a copy of the Second Applicant's Consolidated Replying Affidavit and not the First Respondent's Answering Affidavit as reflected in its index. This error continues into Volume 18.

Second, Volume 19 does not have an individual index.

Third, the Individual Index on Volume 20 incorrectly reflects that Volume 20 ends with Annexure CJA3 when it actually also includes Annexure CJA4 and the start of CJA5. These annexures also appear in Volume 21.
