The Constitutional Court has considered the application for condonation and the application for leave to appeal directly to it and has concluded that the delay in bringing the application for leave to appeal is so excessive and the explanation for the delay so inadequate that it is not necessary to consider whether the application bears reasonable prospects of success. In any event, the application for leave to appeal does not engage the jurisdiction of this Court and no case has been made out for a direct appeal. Condonation must be refused and, as a consequence, the application for leave to appeal fails.

Order: Condonation is refused.
