1. The applicants are directed to deliver to the Registrar and serve on all parties written submissions, of no longer than twenty pages, on or before Friday, 11 May 2018, on:
 - (a) the inter-relationship between relevant provisions of the Refugees Act 130 of 1998 and the Immigration Act 13 of 2002; and
 - (b) whether a court order, made by agreement, can be unilaterally withdrawn in terms of a directive by the respondents.

2. The respondents are directed to deliver to the Registrar and serve on all parties written submissions, of no longer than twenty pages, on or before Monday, 14 May 2018, on the issues referred to in paragraph 1.
3. Further directions may be issued.
