DIRECTIONS IN TERMS OF RULE 19

---

1. The appeal is set down for hearing before the Constitutional Court at 10 a.m. on 7 September 2000
2. The record in the appeal shall consist of the record in the proceedings in the High Court, and the judgment given by Mr Acting Justice Coetzee. The record shall be prepared in accordance with the requirements of rule 19(2) provided that clear photocopies may be used in the preparation of the record. To facilitate the preparation of argument, the appeal record should follow the same pagination as the record in the High Court.
3. The record shall be prepared and lodged by the appellant's attorney by not later than 19 July 2000.
4. Written argument shall be lodged with the registrar of the Constitutional Court as follows  
  
By the appellant, by not later than 1 August.  
By the respondents, by not later than 18 August.
