DIRECTIONS

The following directions have been given by the Chief Justice concerning the above matter.

1. The application for leave to appeal is set down for hearing before the Constitutional Court at 10 a.m. on 11 November 2003.
2. The record in the matter will consist of:
 - a) The record in the High Court.
 - b) The affidavits lodged by the applicant and the respondents in the application for leave to appeal.
3. a) The applicant's attorneys must prepare the record referred to in paragraph 2(a) in accordance with the provisions of rule 19, provided that clear photocopies of documents may be used in the preparation of the record.

- b) The applicant's attorneys must paginate and prepare and lodge an index of the documents referred to in paragraph 2(b) above.
 - c) The record referred to in paragraph 3(a) and the index referred to in paragraph 3(b) must be lodged with the registrar of the Constitutional Court by not later than 23 October 2003. In preparing the record referred to in sub-paragraph (a) the same pagination as that used in the High Court should be followed. This will facilitate the preparation of argument.
4. Written argument shall be lodged as follows:

On behalf of the applicant, by not later than 23 October 2003.

On behalf of the respondent, by not later than 4 November 2003.

The arguments must be sufficient to enable the Court to dispose of the matter without further argument should leave to appeal be granted.
